ENTRIES:	 Swimmers are limited to 4 events per session. The meet will be run on computer using Hy-Tek's Meet Manager. <u>From Long Island</u>: Take Whitestone Bridge, to the Hutchinson Parkway North, to I-684 north, to exit 4 (then proceed as above).

<u>From Saw Mill Parkway North:</u> Take exit 33, Readers Digest Road. Cross railroad tracks and keep right. At traffic light, make a left turn on route 117 (it will become Main Street). Pass 2 traffic lights. Just before the third traffic light, turn right into B/G Club driveway.

<u>From Taconic Parkway South</u>: Take exit for route 133, Mount Kisco. At traffic light, make a right turn. At next traffic light, turn right and follow signs for Mt. Kisco (on route 133 east). Drive approximately 4 miles. At the end of 133, turn right onto route 117 South (Main Street). Pass 2 traffic lights. Just after the 3rd traffic light, make an immediate left turn into the B/G Club driveway..
